3.0 Estimated Cost :

Total yearly estimated financial involvement against Manpower Cost is 36,43,918/- as per Table -1

Estimated Service Charge:5 % of total manpower cost (including GST) **4.0 Quoted Price:**

5.0 Period of contract:

The initial period of contract is for twelve (12) calendar months. However the period may be extended upto thirty six (36) calendar months with fixed percentage service charges based on the satisfactory performance of the contractor and with consent from the contractor.

6.0 Variation Additions and Omissions

WBREDA reserves the right to alter, amend, omit or otherwise vary the requirement of manpower as may be necessary as follows:

a) Increase of Number of Manpower:

The number of manpower may be increased by 50% against each category (in nearest roundup)

b) Decrease of Number of Manpower

The number of manpower may be decreased by **25%** against each category (in nearest roundup) as per Table -1 as above .

WBREDA at any stage of the contact shall add his discretion based on requirement may instruct the contractor to scale down the number of manpower. The contractor, at such circumstances shall carry out the instruction of WBREDA within a period of one month of receiving such instruction. No compensation of any form shall arise as a result of scaling down of operation.

c) <u>New Categories of Manpower</u>

New categories of manpower may be provided by the contractor against the same contract in such case the remuneration of the new category of manpower shall be fixed by WBREDA. The new category of manpower shall be maximum **three (03)**. Number of manpower under new category shall be maximum **five (05)**.

d) Location of Posting

The location of posting of the manpower as mentioned in the Table -1 as above is indicative. The outsourced manpower may be posted at various establishments of WBREDA anywhere in West Bengal as per requirement.

e) Monthly rate of Manpower

Monthly rate of manpower may be reviewed and may be amended time to time if required.

f) Service Charge

The service charge shall be considered based on the actual manpower cost.

7.0 Cost of Tender Document (Tender Fee):

(a) If L1 bidder has quoted bid rate 80% or less of the estimated service charge put to the tender then additional Performance Security @10% of the tendered amount have to be submitted by the bidder in the form of DD, Bankers' Cheque drawn in favor of 'WBREDA' issued by any schedule bank within 7 working days from the date of issuance of Letter of Acceptance by the bidder.

If the bidder fails to submit the Additional Performance Security within schedule time, his EMD will be forfeited.

The Additional Performance Security shall remain valid up to the contract period of **12** (twelve) months with an additional claim period of **ninety (90) days**, failing which his bid security may be forfeited.

In particular it is expressly understood and agreed that the Government is not a party to this Agreement and has no liabilities, obligations or rights hereunder. It is expressly understood and agreed that the Purchaser is an Independent legal entity with power and authority to enter into contracts solely on its own behalf under the applicable laws of India and the general principles of Contract Law. The Contractor expressly agrees, acknowledges and understands that the Purchaser is not an

Agent, Representative or Delegate of the Government. It is further understood and agreed that the Government of West Bengal is not and shall not be liable for any acts, omissions, commissions, breaches or other wrongs arising out of the Contract. Accordingly, the Contractor expressly waives, releases and foregoes any and all actions or claims, including cross claims, impleader claims or counter claims against the Government arising out of this Contract and covenants not to sue the Government as to any manner, claim, cause of action or thing whatsoever arising of or under this Agreement.

3.5. Appendices

The Appendices listed, if any, in the attached list of Appendices shall be deemed to form an integral part of this Contract Agreement. Reference in the Contract to any Appendix shall mean the Appendices attached hereto, and the Contract shall be read and construed accordingly.
